Minutes
April 7th, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:45 pm by Van Webster, Vice-President.

Members present: Connie Chow, Van Webster, Tony Kaap, Mike Burnham, and Odie Tollefson.

Treasurer's Report - Connie is maintaining accounts and writing checks as necessary.

Old Business

- 501 (c) (3) – Gary signed the letter as per IRS request which completes our response to them.
- 75th Anniversary celebration – Still working on a meeting with the appropriate individuals at the City of Pasadena offices which is being coordinated by Jim. There was discussion regarding shirts and the 20 pins program. More research will be done on the shirts with the goal being to keep the per piece price closer to \$20-\$25.
- Oak Tree Shoot – A check was prepared and delivered for payment of the 3D animal order. Decisions need to be made as to where to store them once they are delivered. Renting a storage space or splitting the cost of one with someone else needing particle space was discussed. Mike agreed to check the printed materials for consistency so they can be ordered. Ideas for new stakes were discussed. One suggestion was to use white 9x12 envelopes that would cover the stakes. As we get closer to the event, we will post information on Facebook with the details of the event.
- Work day – Nine members helped out on March 20th cleaning shooting lanes, raking and moving rocks to mark return lanes. With the work on the drip irrigation system being put in throughout the range, there are rocks around that will be used to further mark lanes once the city completes its work.
- Membership Chair update – The latest roster was distributed to the Board. There are 133 memberships representing 284 total members.
- Webmaster update – It was suggested that the directions to the range be both on the top banner and in the “contact us” section. It was also suggested that the “Follow us on Facebook” tag be larger.
- Patch and Pin program update – The 20 pins have been purchased. Rolling out the program needs further discussion at the next general meeting.
- Haiti Shootathon – The event raised approximately \$400.
- Body Wise event – Kate MacQuarrie and Elizabeth Spiers were at the PRA booth. There were over 300 participants, but the schedule did not allow them an opportunity to mill around the booths because they were in break out sessions most of the day.
- Conceptual drawings – Some additional work to the conceptual drawings is in process.

New Business

- Bale order – An order needs to be placed as there are only 5 new bales left at the range. Mike will follow up with the supplier.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 5th at Van's Studio.
