Treasurer's Report - Report prepared by Irene Yin, Treasurer, was presented to members present

Old Business

- 501 (c) (3) – Bob anticipates having the completed paperwork within the next few weeks.
- Bales – The financials do not show a refund. There is no further update at this time.
- Work Day April 18 - There were 9 members that cleared weeds from paths, steps, and animal placement areas. The steps and animal platforms were also leveled. Next work day is May 16<sup>th</sup>, the Saturday before the Oak Tree. The targets will be set up on Saturday. A volunteer is needed to patrol the range on Saturday evening and to go to the range early to help prevent vandalism.

Three canopies will be needed for the event. A total of 5 tables are needed. Jay has some tables. Any additional tables needed will be rented. Help is needed at registration and score keeping.
- 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration – Gary will follow up with Jim M.
- Emergency Contact List – Gary has prepared a list. Van is reviewing it and will forward it to another board member once he completes his review.

New Business

- 20 pins program – There was some discussion regarding an intermediate reward program. Gary will do some research.
- During the first 4 months of 2009 382 first time shooters have attended PRA classes. There were 921 archer contacts. These numbers are slightly down from 2008. It was noted that three weekends saw rain which may be why the numbers are down from last year.
- Complaints – Formal complaints were reviewed. The main concern is archers shooting crossways on the range.
