Minutes  
June 1st, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Gary Spiers, President.

Treasurer's Report - Connie reviewed balances in both checking accounts.

Old Business

- 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration – The decision to make white polo shirts with the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary logo embroidered available to club members. Gary will confirm prices with his contact. A meeting with Charles at the City of Pasadena offices is scheduled for June 8<sup>th</sup>. Gary and Jim plan to attend.

The standing bear target needs to be replaced before the Trad Shoot in October. A two month lead time is needed. There was discussion regarding checking into using a not truck for future events. The City will need to be contacted to confirm this can be done.
- Range maintenance – The issue of ensuring that club members do not trim trees inappropriately was discussed. It was determined that it is best to disseminate that information through Eric as the Volunteer Coordinator when he coordinates work days.
- Website update – Tony will add verbiage regarding our 501(c)(3) status to the website. Gary reviewed several sections of the website that need to be updated. Adding a communication/news section to the website was discussed. Web hosting and updating the website was also discussed.
- Membership Chair update – There are currently 238 members.
- City of Pasadena brochures - Information regarding the PRA program on the brochures needs to be updated before the City prints the brochures next year.

New Business
