Minutes
June 4, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by President, Truett Sparkman.

Old Business

- Oak Tree Event update/results– 102 shooters participated. The approximate profit was \$470. There was discussion of the reasons for the lower profits; food sales were down as was the raffle amount collected. Future event's costs incurred by members will be reimbursed via check rather than cash payments being made from dollars collected at the event. Also discussed was the need for an event-day accountant that handles the financial needs.
- 501 (c) (3) - Fees that still need to be paid will be detailed at the next meeting. We are awaiting a reply from the IRS.
- State Field Championship – June 22, 2008 - Bob is ordering one porta potty which will be delivered on Friday, June 20th and picked up on Monday, June 23. It was suggested that a bow rack be placed outside the porta potty. Jeriel agreed to again rent the generator. The contact e-mail for the event is longbowchuck@comcast.net Gary will be adding the registration form to the PRA website. PRA members are welcome to shoot the event. Individuals must be CBH or SAA members to be eligible for awards. One more E-Z Up (10 or 12 foot) is needed. Members will be asked if they have one that can be borrowed for the day. Six more tables are also needed. There was discussion as to whether to buy or rent the tables. Due to lack of storage, renting them may be the best option. Large pieces of cardboard are needed for the targets. There will not be a raffle at the event. Odie will send an e-mail asking for volunteers for this event.
- Work Day – June 21st – There are several things to do to ensure the range is ready for the State Field Championships. Javier will be painting the markers over the next couple of weeks. Truett and Donna will help him as needed.
- Benches at range – Chris MacQuarrie's project of building several new benches was completed and the benches look great. Truett will send a formal thank you letter.
