July 1, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Gary Spiers, President.

Treasurer's Report - Report prepared by Irene Yin, Treasurer, was presented to members present. There was a correction/adjustment made on the Heritage account. The club netted approximately \$1,000 on the Oak Tree event.

Old Business

- 501 (c) (3) – The status was briefly discussed..
- Bales – There was no new update at this time. It was again noted that we did not receive 7 bales that we ordered.
- 75th Anniversary celebration – A discussion group has been created on Facebook for anyone wishing to begin and/or participate in discussions. Donna Sparkman and Joann Heithe have both agreed to help with the planning of the celebration events.
- 20 pins program – Mike reviewed the rules of the program from NFAA. PRA plans to place a pin order in November so they can be presented at the Banquet in January. Mike Burnham will prepare an article for Mike Larsen to publish in the next newsletter. Gary will make a note on Facebook and on the PRA website.
- Woodley & PRA joint field and target shoot – Since there has not been an agreed on date, this is on hold for now.
- PRA Trad Shoot – The date for the shoot will be October 25th.
- Potluck at the range – It will be held on Sunday, August 30th after shooting/approximate start time between 12:30 and 1pm. Gary will add the information on Facebook and on the website. Gary will prepare an announcement and sent it to Mike who will send it out to the membership.

New Business

- July work day – Eric will coordinate. He will also continue to paste targets for the 300 rounds. It was discussed that the Saturday class needs D targets and the markers need to be repainted. The date in July is Saturday, July 25th. Additional areas that need work include moving all the trash from around many of the targets to the front near the bridge so the City of Pasadena can arrange for pick up. Several return lanes also need work. The bow rack on target 14 is missing. The bow rack on target 16 needs to be moved back. It would be great to have racks at both ends of each target.
- Facebook – Gary has created a PRA presence on Facebook.
- Boy Scout Project – Matt Sakai would like his Eagle Scout project to benefit PRA. The project requirements are that a Boy Scout lead a group in 100 man hours of work. Bruce Morrison will be contacted to determine what materials he may have left from prior projects that might help Matt in coordinating the building of some of the bow racks as noted above. Matt was asked to come to the range on a Saturday and do an inventory with a PRA member so he can prepare a proposal to be presented to the PRA Board for approval.
