Minutes

July 7th, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm by Van Webster, Vice-President.

Members present: Connie Chow, Van Webster, Tony Kaap, Mike Burnham, Jeriel Nutter, Mehdi Sabounchi and Odie Tollefson.

Treasurer's Report - Connie reviewed annual figures, 7/1/09 to 6/30/10.

Old Business

- 75th Anniversary celebration – Mike will order the pins with the 75th anniversary logo. Tony will discuss survey options with Gary so one can be prepared and sent to the membership to determine the size of the order. Gary to consider a sub-committee to address the details of the 75th anniversary celebration. The original dates discussed for the weekend shoots are October 23rd and 24th. The City of Pasadena has an event schedule on the 23rd that will prevent access to the range. The 24th is when the Traditional Shoot is scheduled. October 30th is being considered for the celebration at the Casa de Arroyo. It is currently available so we must decide soon to confirm the date with the City.
- Website update – Tony has researched several options for hosting the PRA website. He will proceed with making a change to fatcow.com
- Woodley & PRA Fun Shoot August 7 & 8 – Van will check with Gary to confirm whether the flyers have been distributed.
- Education program update – Still having large turn out each weekend which we are unable to accommodate. Many groups are coordinating events after the Saturday morning classes. Van announced he will be putting on a Community Coach course in September.
- Feedback on potluck held 6/27 – Everyone felt the event was well-received. Several attendees commented they should be held more often. The idea of holding a 21 or Bust for members was brought up.
- Membership Chair update – Mike reviewed some interesting historical membership statistics that he gathered from various sources. The membership fees discussion was tabled for one more meeting.
- Security at the range – After speaking with the City, there has been a noticeable increase in the presence of security.

New Business

- Compound class – Mike has offered to teach a 4 week compound class. He will create a flyer so a waiting list can be started. An exact date to be determined after Mike handles some personal health issues.
- Bale order – Mike has placed an order for 40 new bales. Delivery will be determined when the vendor has additional orders heading to California so he sends a full truck.
- NPR show – The show was taped on the range. Van will notify everyone of the date when it will air.
- Work day task – The issue of safety due to non-archers using the “trail” that runs along/near the targets continues to be a concern. Ideally, it would be helpful to obscure that trail. It was suggested that boulders from throughout the range be moved onto the trail to discourage walking and jogging. A trail can be created alongside the actual bales to put up and take down the weekend shoot targets.
- CPR Classes for instructors and coaches – Mehdi, a new PRA member, has offered to provide CPR classes to all PRA instructors and coaches at no cost. Van offered to use his studio. Van and Mehdi will coordinate two dates and times so that all instructors can be accommodated.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 4th at Van's Studio.
