

Pasadena Roving Archers
Minutes
July 13, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 11:10 am by Vice President, Van Webster.

Members present: Van Webster, Jeriel Nutter, Bruce Morrison, Michael Burnham, Christophe Convert, Bob Thome, Stephanie Thome, Karen and Carl Nelson, and Eric and Odie Tollefson.

Treasurer's Report Mike Burnham presented the Treasurer's Report.

Old Business

- 501 (c) (3) – Bob updated the group that the we are looking to file for the 50(c)(3) as an educational organization. Information has been provided to Irene from Van, PRA brochures and website. Filing is anticipated to be done this coming week.
- State Field Championship Update – June 22, 2008 - Van shared that there were 58 attendees. The help from PRA members was great. Forty percent of the fees from the shooters will be given to PRA by the State for hosting the event. From a financial standpoint, it was a break-even undertaking, but was well-worth doing from the standpoint of the State archery community. There were some complaints about the event being held in one day. Those comments were shared with the state organizers. Jeriel turned in the receipt for the rental of the generator for reimbursement.

New Business

- Additional shelving in the bin – Jeriel brought up how additional shelving in the bin would be very helpful in organizing all that is stored in it. He requested approval to purchase the supplies necessary to do the work. Van noted that if the cost of supplies was under \$200, Jeriel needs to turn in receipts for reimbursement. Jeriel feels that the cost would be well under that amount and agreed to proceed with the project.
- No clean up day is scheduled for July. Mike's Saturday morning class will be repositioning the meter markers on target 14 after class on July 19th.
- Van reviewed statistics of the numbers of new students going through the Saturday morning class and plans for addressing the student-to-instructor ratio. Approximately 1500 individuals have gone through the basic program in the first 6 months of 2008. Van is working on a change to the system in place for Saturday morning instructor commitment.
- There are several upcoming events to be held on the range and agreements have been reached with each group as to the costs involved.
- Additional class added to the Basic Archery Instruction Program (BAIP) making it a 7 week program. The additional class will be held on a Sunday where the class will be taken through a 14 target field round.
- Jeriel asked is a packet of maps with addresses to local archery ranges and shops could be put together to give individuals becoming involved with the sport.
- Bruce brought up that a quiver with 6 arrows was left behind at the range a few weeks ago. If anyone saw it, please let him know.
- Mike shared that he will be writing articles for the newsletter regarding the State Outdoor and the California State Games tournaments.

The next meeting will be held on August 6th at 7:30 pm at Van's studio.
