

# Pasadena Roving Archers

## Minutes

August 6, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm by Truett Sparkman, President.

Members present: Donna and Truett Sparkman, Van Webster, Jeriel Nutter, Bruce Morrison, Michael Burnham, Irene Yin, Gary Spiers and Eric and Odie Tollefson.

Treasurer's Report Mike Burnham presented the Treasurer's Report. Mike and Irene visited Joanne on Sunday, July 27 to review how Joanne has kept the books in the past and to pass the baton to Irene. Mike will take club money collected on Saturday's and Sunday's to Irene on Sunday's after shooting for Irene to deposit into the appropriate bank account(s).

### Old Business

- 501 (c) (3) – No update available.
- Shelving update – Jeriel is doing a little at a time. He is putting up some walls in areas next.
- Education update – Van shared that there are young kids who are interested in instruction. To work with them requires one on one instruction. One consideration is to have one adult and several teenagers trained as Level 1 instructors for this purpose. Also discussed was the system of instructors confirming their attendance on Saturday's to determine how many people can participate in class. Those that commit do come and help. The interest on the part of shooters is high, but due to the large numbers of shooters and the lack of instructors, many are being turned away each Saturday.

### New Business

- 21 or Bust! – It is on the state schedule for November 16<sup>th</sup>. Bob Thome will be ordering one porta potty for the event. There was discussion about speaking with Rosa at the City of Pasadena offices regarding having the city bring power up to the old connector so as not to have to rent a generator. Van agreed to e-mail Rosa. Mike will do an inventory of the trophies on hand to determine what needs to be purchased. New targets will be ordered. The JOAD kids will be asked to color in the targets. After some discussion, it was decided that there will be no raffle at the event. The food needs to be set up out front rather than back where it is out of sight. Donna will contact Adela to see if she will cook the food. There was discussion on the best use of dollars for advertising. Some ideas reviewed were to do a quarter page ad in September and a half page ad in October rather than a half page and full page as has been done in prior years. Also discussed was putting flyers in all the archery shops, posting information on the PRA website, and writing an article in Archery Talk about the history of the tournament and inviting people to participate this year. Articles do not have a cost attached. Another suggestion made was to include a line on the registration form for people to write their e-mail address so we can create our own database for future use.
